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Foreword

This list of additional learning resources identifies high-quality resources that have been recommended by the Ministry of Education to support Prekindergarten and the Kindergarten curriculum. A list of core (**CORE**) learning resources is also available on the Ministry of Education website. This list offers suggestions, where appropriate, for other renewed curricula that the resources will support. The list will be updated as new resources are recommended and older ones are no longer available.

The suggested uses indicate that the resources are general professional resources or student or professional resources that support a particular area of study within the Kindergarten curriculum. Many of the resources, however, support Prekindergarten programs as well; in such cases, this is indicated on the grade graphic at the top of each page. In addition to professional resources, the recommended resources support language and literacy development throughout the Prekindergarten program. The suggested uses for Prekindergarten indicate support for particular areas of early learning: social-emotional, physical, spiritual, and intellectual.


