
**Helpful Kangaroo**  
Ask for help.




**Chunky Monkey**

Look for a word part.




**Eagle Eye**  
Look at the picture for clues




**Lips the Fish**

Try to reread the sentence. Try a word that makes sense

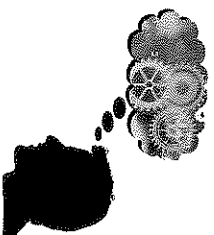
